BYE-LAWS

SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

(a) These Bye-Laws shall be called the Bye-Laws of the Maharashtra Tribal Public Schools Society, Nashik (Maharashtra State).

(b) They shall come into force with effect from the date of Registration of the Society.

2. JURISDICTION

Jurisdiction of the Society will be the State of Maharashtra.

3. DEFINITIONS

Under these rules, unless otherwise specified.

(a) "Society" means the Maharashtra Tribal Public Schools Society (Regd.), Nashik.

(b) "General Body" means General Body of the Society constituted under Article 5 (A) of the Memorandum of Association.

(c) "Board" means Board of Governors / Governing Council constituted under Article 5 (B) of the Memorandum of Association.

(d) "Bye-laws" means Bye-Laws made by the Society and approved by the competent authority.

(e) "Rules and Regulations" means rules and regulations made by the Board of Governors and approved by General Body.

(f) "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Society and the Board of the Governors appointed by Government under Article 5 of the Memorandum of Association.

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12. SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

If in the opinion of the Chairman / Member Secretary, immediate action is called for on any matter and it is not possible to convene the meeting he may take action and the action so taken shall be placed before the next meeting of the General Body.

13. AUTHORITIES OF THE SOCIETY

- 1) The General Body.
- 2) The Board of Governors (Board).
- 3) The Chairman and the Member Secretary.
- 4) The Local Managing Committees. (If appointed by Board)


14. BOARD OF TRUSTEES OR GOVERNORS (GOVERNING COUNCIL)

Subject to other provisions of these rules, regular day to day management, supervision and control of the Society shall vest in the Board of Governors which shall consist of twelve members from amongst the members of the Society which include Chairman, Member Secretary and ten other members nominated by Government.

The management of the Society shall vest in a Board of Governors consisting of twelve Ex-Officio (Government Officials) members as shown below :

15. POWER AND FUNCTION OF BOARD OF GOVERNORS (GOVERNING COUNCIL)

- 1) It is empowered to take all measures considered necessary for the attainment of specified objectives of the Society.
- 2) The Board shall carry out and exercise the following functions and powers.
 - a) To approve annual budget.
 - b) To approve the expenditure.
 - c) To take decisions in matters that may be referred to it by the Central or State Government or by the Chairman.
 - d) To undertake any other activity that is consistent with the aims and objectives of the Society.
 - e) To maintain proper accounts which should be regularly audited by the appropriate authority.
 - f) Inspect and supervise the implementation of the Scheme.
